

KidSingers Donor Privacy Policy

KidSingers is committed to respecting the privacy of our donors.

Information Collected. Here are the types of donor information that we collect and maintain:

- contact information: name, organization/company, complete address, phone number, email address
- donation information: amounts donated, date of donation(s), method and stimulus information concerning hours you have volunteered
- your requests and comments
- information gathered from database modeling firms
- non-personally identifiable information, such as how many hits each KidSingers website page receives, and if the visitor is repeat or new. This requires that a 'cookie' be sent to your web browser.

How Information is Used.

KidSingers uses your data to maintain records of donations, send acknowledgments, mail year-end tax statements to you, send newsletters, notices, and direct mail pieces, and for internal marketing purposes.

We normally add you to our mailing list unless you request otherwise. Our third-party mailing service is contractually obligated to treat the lists with confidentiality and prohibits transferring them elsewhere.

We do list individuals' names in concert publications unless you decide to opt-out. Corporate and Foundation sponsors are listed in our Annual Report and event programs.

We use your written comments/letters occasionally to post on our website (in an anonymous fashion) and to respond to your inquiries.

Credit card numbers are only retained if you signed up for a monthly donation other wise once processed credit card numbers are not stored. Our website has a SSL certificate. Donations over 2% of our entire budget must be reported on IRS Form 990, Schedule B. We use website statistics to analyze our website usage. If you create a personal URL at kidsingers.org, that information is used to personalize your internet experience.

No Sharing of Personal Information.

KidSingers will not sell, rent, trade or transfer your personal information to outside organizations. Use of donor information will be limited to the internal purposes of KidSingers and only to further the mission of KidSingers. Nevertheless, security measures may not prevent all losses, and KidSingers is not responsible for any damages or liabilities relating to security failures.
