

KidSingers was founded in 1997, and from the first day it has been changing lives for the better. Whether singing for the governor, performing at an Angel's game, or providing a safe haven where a child can grow in musical skills, self-esteem and confidence; the ultimate objective of this award-winning youth chorus has always been the same: To help kids realize

and achieve their highest individual potential. And it's working!









...the Program

KidSingers is an inner-city, 150-voice, after school choral music education and performance program for at-risk youth in grades 3-12. Drawing kids from 45 different schools in the

Santa Ana Unified School
District and surrounding area,
KidSingers is comprised of
95% Hispanic youth with
40% of the enrollment boys.





KidSingers has long upheld its commitment to serving youth in the Santa Ana area by providing children with an encouraging environment in which to explore their talents and interact with each other. KidSingers is the only after-school music program in Santa Ana that provides free choral music instruction and performance opportunities on a consistent and on-going basis to youth who could not otherwise afford it. Structured into four age-appropriate choruses, KidSingers participate in highly disciplined rehearsals where they learn the art of singing and performing. KidSingers consistently takes kids with little or no singing experience and transforms them into a dynamic performing ensemble!

...the Need

Due to state budget cuts, music programs in public schools are the first to be axed. Though supported by many noted studies about how music stimulates the learning centers of the brain and increases reasoning abilities, music education still faces near extinction. Since 1997, *KidSingers* has been the only after school music program in Santa Ana to help fill the gap.

Recent studies characterized Santa Ana as one of the greatest urban hardship cities in the nation. During the after school hours of 3:00pm and 7:00pm, reports also show that gang activity and criminal behavior in youth is increasing. Kids in this geographical area are at great risk of falling into destructive behavior. *KidSingers* provides a safe haven by reaching out to these vulnerable youth to help fill this dangerous void.

I am confident that **KidSingers** plays an important preventive role in providing the kind of enrichment activities that could have prevented many of the problems I observed when children entered Orangewood Children's Home and the juvenile justice system.

... the Evaluation

The University of California at Irvine conducted a study to evaluate *KidSingers*. They documented some very impressive findings.

- 100% of KidSingers learned music theory, singing and performing techniques
- 87% increased in self esteem
- 87% more confident about themselves
- 85% learned to respect other people and cultures
- 65% more confident about speaking in front of their class

The impact of any program is measured by how it affects lives for the better. *KidSingers'* parents, teachers and the kids themselves, all testify to the positive effect KidSingers has had on their lives.

Musical Achievement: Kids improve their ability to read music, perform and project with confidence.

"I have learned more about notes, what staffs are and how to read music. What's cool is I learn and have fun."

"I have learned to sing from my diaphragm and have correct posture."

"What I like best about **KidSingers** is that I send music to people's hearts."

"I have learned how to sing the scale and to do sign language for all the notes." Academic achievement: Parents and teachers have expressed how kids improve in academic areas, especially reading, language skills and spelling.

"Gangs are everywhere and many people get hurt by them. When I was little I lived in a very bad area where shootings were going on day and night. I was sometimes scared to go home because I didn't know if I would get in the middle of the crossfire. KidSingers was the place I could fall back on. I didn't have anywhere else to go until I came here and they assured me that I would be fine and made sure of that. I have seen many of my friends get hurt by drugs, alcohol and gang violence. I have tried to help them and show them that there is a better life than the gang life that they are in now.
